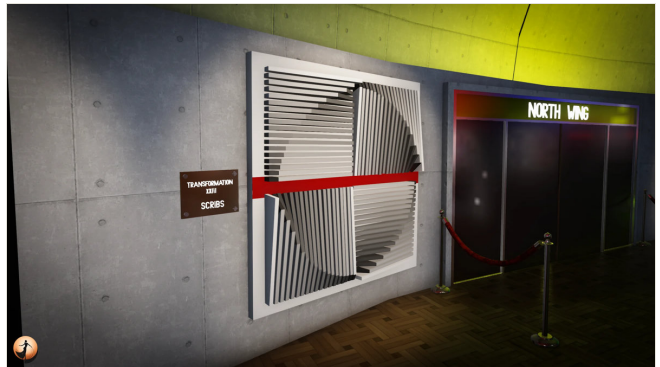
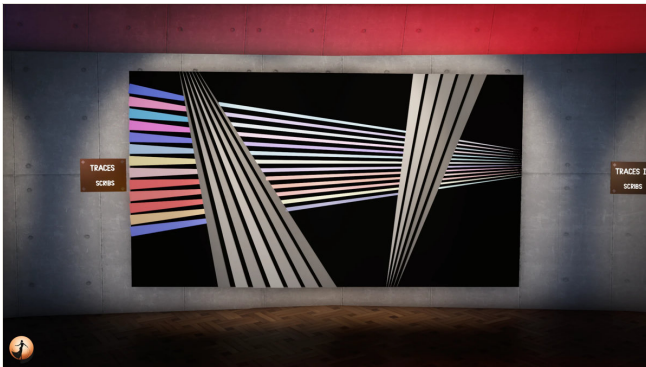
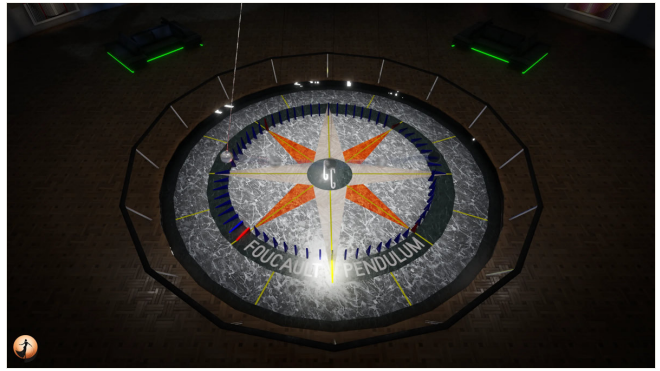


Glyptotheca Galleria

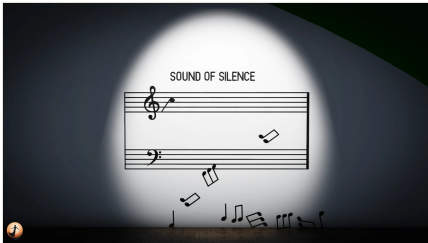

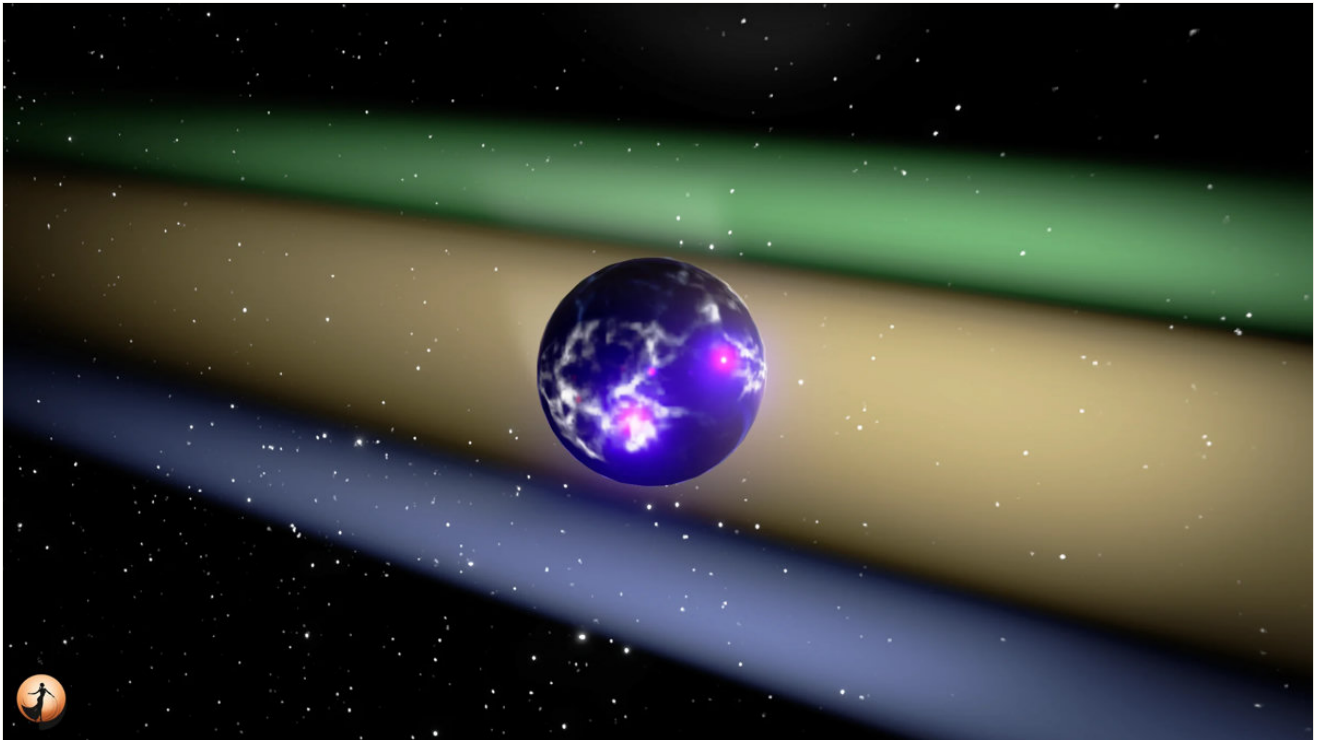
The "22 a day" under the names is a nod to the 22 veterans per day that remove themselves from their pain.
